

## **Diving For Life 2000**

Once again, we invite you to join us for the Annual International Gay and Lesbian Scuba Jamboree. For this, our ninth Jamboree, we will be traveling

ON TO CURACAO - For 2000, we will be traveling to Curação, Netherlands Antilles- 30 miles from Bonaire, the site of Jamborees 2 and 6. "Diving Freedom" is the slogan for Habitat Curacao, a PADI five start training and instructor development center with the same owners as Captain Don's Habitat in Bonaire. Pristine coral reef formations with over 400 species of fish, crustacean, sponges, anemones and invertebrates are available off the Habitat's pier and at over 100 dive sites in the area. Local marine biologists are predicting the spawning of these reefs while we are there and will join us for an educational presentation. The resort has three choices of rooms that will accommodate up to 152 people. All rooms are air-conditioned and have t.v.'s and coffeepots. They range from 4-person cottages to deluxe, ocean view doubles. Meals are served in the RumRunner, the resort's multi-terraced restaurant and bar. The Habitat's sandy beach and pool offer unlimited vistas of the Caribbean Sea. The resort offers free, daytime shuttle service to the town of Willemstad, noted for its shopping, restaurants, bistros, scenery, museums, casinos and clubs. Jamboree will include a "Casino Night" in Willemstad and a DFL Talent show at the resort.

LAND PACKAGE – Diving for Life offers three choices of accommodations this year, all priced affordably. 10 two-bedroom (2 twins/l queen) cottages are available at \$853 per person, 4 person occupancy. 16 double occupancy garden view rooms are available for \$975 per person, and 40 double occupancy ocean view rooms are available for \$1146 per person. Non-divers deduct \$100 from the price, and single supplements (available with the garden and-ocean view units) cost an additional \$975 and \$1146.

PACKAGE INCLUDES:

Rooms: seven nights accommodation (double occupancy) in air-conditioned rooms with kitchenette/refrigerator/t.v. All rooms will be assigned on a first-come-first served basis, and while every effort will be made to provide the room category desired, registrants will be asked their second and third choices in case their first choice is not available.

Meals: Starting the first Saturday dinner to the second Saturday breakfast, there will be three meals daily. Beverages are not included with lunch or dinner.

Diving: Six days of two-tank boat dives, unlimited shore diving, air/tanks/weights. Entertainment: Includes a welcome reception, Casino Night, BBQ Dinner, 70's Disco Party and the First Ever DFL Talent Show.



Gratuities: for restaurant staff are included in the package price. Note: gratuities for the dive operation and other hotel staff are not included in the price of the land package. Airport Transfers: Transfers to and from the airport are included in the land package

DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE: A deposit of \$300 by check, money order or credit card authorization must accompany your registration form. \$150 of the deposit is refundable until May 1, 2000. None of the \$300 deposit is refundable after May 1, 2000. The balance of payment is due by June 2, 2000. For those canceling after June 2, 2000, Diving for Life will replace them with the next person on the waiting list or, absent a waiting list, the person canceling may provide a replacement. Only in the event of a replacement found will a refund be made. In each instance where a credit card payment is not approved for any reason, a surcharge of \$25 will be charged.

DIVING FOR LIFE: is incorporated as a not-forprofit, 501 (c)(3) organization with a mission to raise funds through the Annual International Gay and Lesbian Scuba Jamboree for gay men's and lesbians' health services in communities where participating gay and lesbian scuba clubs are located. DFL has an all-volunteer board of directors who derive no income or salaries from the Jamboree. Over the past few years, 90% of the money raised has been donated to local gay and lesbian health charities. Each club with participating members in the Jamboree receives a proportionate share of the funds. For each of the last two years. Diving for Life raised and distributed \$46,000. To date, the total amount of money raised by Diving for Life has exceeded \$183,000.
